

How to Collect Urine From Your Cat

1. To collect urine, replace your normal litter with a substance like plastic foam packing , aquarium gravel, or a litter that will not absorb urine. See *Figure 3*

2. After your cat has urinated, pour the urine from the litter pan into a small, clean container.

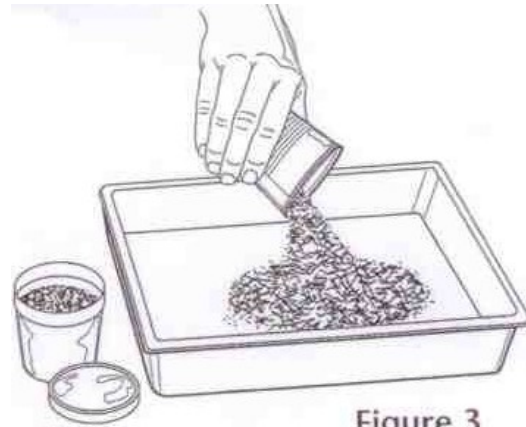

3. If the urine sample is for your veterinarian's analysis, transfer it to another container provided or suggested by your veterinarian. This sample should be given to your veterinarian as soon as possible.
4. For the most accurate results, the sample should be tested within one half-hour and certainly within two hours. It may be stored temporarily in the refrigerator if necessary.
